Week of:

October 18 - Lesson 1 - How do we know God?

- God is truth and love.

November 8 - Lesson 4 - Who is Jesus Christ?

- The Incarnation is the mystery that Jesus, the only Son of God, became human.
- Jesus is the Savior who came into the world to save us from sin.
- At the Ascension, the Risen Christ was taken up into heaven.

- The People of God are the temple of the Holy Spirit and the sacrament of Christ.
- The Church is divinely established, motivated by love, and guided by the Holy Spirit.
